Policy for M-Governance services/solutions for state Govts. & PSUs was circulated to all CGM of all Telecom Circles / Districts / NTR vide this office letter of even no. dated 13-04-2010. Thereafter, clarifications on certain points, were conveyed vide this office letter of even no. dated 09-06-2010.

The policy regarding security amount for ASP commitment for smooth running of service has been reviewed and following modifications are issued with approval of competent authority:

Clause as per earlier approval

To ensure ASP commitment for smooth running of services following may be ensured

- **a. CAPEX Model:** AMC/O&M charges of upto **2** months may be kept as security.
- b. Transaction charge model: Transaction charges of 2 months may be retained as security.

Thereafter in both the cases payment of AMC/O&M charges or Transaction charges may be made on monthly basis after retraining BSNL share

Approved clause now

To ensure ASP commitment for smooth running of services following may be ensured

- a. CAPEX Model: AMC/O&M charges of upto one month may be kept as security.
- b. Transaction charge model: Transaction charges of one month may be retained as security.

Thereafter in both the cases payment of AMC/O&M charges or Transaction charges may be made on monthly basis after retraining BSNL share.

ASP may also be allowed to submit a **Bank Guarantee** in lieu of above security amount. If ASP submits a BG of equivalent amount; the above mentioned amount may be released.

There shall be no change in the performance security which is taken @ 5% (of CAPEX or 1 year of Transaction charges) to ensure ASP commitment for launch/commissioning of services at the time of acceptance of PO and is to be released after 3 months of commissioning of services.

All other items mentioned in earlier letter of even number dated: 09-06-2010 shall remain the same.
