Sir,

DOT vide letter No. 800-23/2015-AS-II dated 13.2.2020 (copy enclosed) has clarified the following on the subject matter :

“As per Temporary Suspension of Telecom Services (Public Emergency or Public Safety) Rules, 2017, directions to suspend the telecom services shall not be issued except by an order made by the Secretary to the Government of India in the Ministry of Home Affairs in the case of Government of India ; or by the Secretary to the State Government in-charge of the Home Department in the case of a State Government.

2. In this regard, it is intimated that cases of white listing of any Mobile, Landline (including Broadband connections) and other Telecom Services during suspension of Telecom services, may be done by the same Competent Authority which issues the direction for suspension under the subject rule.”

Accordingly, I have been directed by Competent Authority to request you that aforesaid instructions should be followed scrupulously.
