DOT should clarify that Government pension & PSU salary will be paid concurrently and terminal benefits will be given as per DOPT OM. No. 28016/5/85-Estt.(C) dated 31.01.1986 and subsequent amendments.

Attention is drawn towards Rule 55-A of CCS Pension Rules pertaining to Dearness Relief on pension/family pension is reproduced below:

'55-A. Dearness Relief on Pension/Family Pension

Relief against price rise may be granted to the pensioners and family pensioners in the form of dearness relief at such rates and subject to such conditions as the Central Government may specify from time to time.

If a pensioner is re-employed under the Central or State Government or a Corporation/Company/Body/Bank under them in India or abroad including permanent absorption in such

Corporation/Company/Body/Bank, he shall not been eligible to draw Dearness Relief on pension/family pension during the period of such re-employment'.

Therefore, as a logical consequence as soon as such reemployment ceases the Dearness Relief on Pension/Family Pension will stand restored.
